KASICH ANNOUNCES HEALTH DIRECTOR'S RETURN TO PRIVATE PRACTICE

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced that Ohio Department of Health Director Dr. Ted Wymyslo has decided to return to private medical practice and will step down at the end of February.
