**Kasich Orders Flags in Geauga County and at Statehouse to Be Flown at Half-Staff In Honor of Slain Chardon High School Student**

COLUMBUS—Tonight Gov. John R. Kasich ordered flags at the Statehouse flown at half-staff tomorrow in honor of the life of Daniel Parmertor, a student at Chardon High School who was slain in today's shooting. Flags in Geauga County will also be flown at half-staff.

Kasich issued the following statement:

"Ohio grieves today with the Parmertor family for the tragic loss of their son and brother Danny. It may seem like we're powerless to reach them right now, but the power of our prayer is great and the Lord is reaching out to them now in ways we cannot fathom. I urge all Ohioans to join me in lifting up this family, the other wounded students and their families and the entire Chardon community at this difficult time."
