MORaine, Ohio (WDTN) – Only 2 NEWS met one-on-one with the man bringing hundreds of jobs to the former General Motors plant in Moraine.

The chairman of Fuyao, a Chinese automotive glass manufacturer, said his company paid \$15 million for 1.4 million square feet of the north end of the plant that shuttered in 2008.

Governor John Kasich's office said it's the largest Chinese investment ever made in Ohio.

Fuyao chairman wants Moraine plant to be company's biggest

Dayton — Chinese automotive glass manufacturer Fuyao finished the deal to purchase a portion of the former General Motors Assembly plant in Moraine, the company's chairman announced today.

Chairman Cao Dewang said through an interpreter that the company, which will be called Fuyao Glass America, looks forward to being "a good neighbor and a friend" to the Dayton community.

Dewang said he paid \$15 million for the plant, adding hiring would begin next week for managers and engineers. Some people are already at the plant from China, the chairman said.

"We hope to make Moraine Fuyao's biggest plant," Dewang said.

P&G to create 800 jobs at new Dayton-area warehouse

Procter & Gamble will build a huge new distribution center in suburban Dayton, indirectly creating 800 new jobs, Ohio's privately run economic development group said Thursday.

The 1 million-square-foot distribution center is one of six new facilities strategically located around the country so P&G can ship more products – everything from Pantene shampoo to Pampers diapers – to U.S. retailers within a single day.

The planned \$89 million facility will be almost as big as the Kenwood Towne Centre.
