On Tuesday, June 28th Lieutenant Governor Mary Taylor led a roundtable discussion with business members of the Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber of Commerce. She shared the results of CSI having reviewed over 7,850 rules, of which a little more than 59% have been amended or rescinded. This has contributed to Ohio's climb from 10th to 5th in Forbes' annual "Best States for Business and Careers." She also discussed the [Ohio Business Gateway Modernization Project](#).

Earlier on June 28th, Lt. Governor Taylor participated in renaming the Port Columbus International Airport to honor John Glenn. At this event she had the opportunity to meet a future astronaut.
