**KASICH SIGNS FOUR BILLS INTO LAW**

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich signed the following pieces of legislation into law:

**Am. H.B. 207** (Balderson, Letson) names the week of Labor Day as annual “Ohio Coal Miners Week;”

**Sub. H.B. 326** (McClain, Hill) prohibits the use of public funds for campaign purposes; states that any person or group who violates this prohibition is guilty of a first degree misdemeanor;

**Sub. S.B. 294** (Schaffer) revises laws governing protection of the environment; and

**Sub. S.B. 310** (Balderson) creates regulations governing the ownership of dangerous wild animals and snakes classified as restricted ([view fact sheet here](#)).
