**KASICH APPOINTS WHITMAN TO CUYAHOGA COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Anjanette C. Arabian Whitman of Rocky River (Cuyahoga Co.) to serve as Judge of the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division. Whitman will assume office on June 18, 2012. She must run in November 2012 to retain the seat for the unexpired term which ends December 31, 2016.

Whitman received a bachelor's degree from the University of Virginia and earned her juris doctorate degree from the Cleveland-Marshall College of Law. She currently is the sole practitioner of Anjanette C. Arabian, LLC, focusing on family law, which she has done since 2003. She also serves as a City Council Member At-Large for the Rocky River City Council, a position she has held since 2008.

Whitman is a member of the Rocky River Parks and Recreation Commission and the Rocky River Community Coalition. Since 2002, she has coached cross country and track at Magnificat High School.
