**KASICH APPOINTS TIM GRENDALL TO GEAUGA COUNTY COURT OF COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS - Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Tim Grendell of Chesterland (Geauga Co.) to serve as judge of the Geauga County Court of Common Pleas. Grendell will assume office on September 21, 2011 and must run in November 2012 in order to serve out the remainder of the unexpired term ending February 8, 2015.

Grendell earned his bachelor's degree from John Carroll University, his juris doctor from Case Western Reserve School of Law and his LLM from the University of Virginia Law School. He is currently a member of the Ohio Senate where he chairs the Judiciary – Criminal Justice Committee.

Grendell previously served as a Captain in the U.S. Army Judge Advocate General's Corps. As a member of the Ohio General Assembly he has helped lead efforts to reform criminal statutes for adults and juveniles, strengthen Ohio's drunk driving laws and combat human trafficking in Ohio.
