**KASICH APPOINTS BARKER TO CUYAHOGA COUNTY COURT OF COMMON

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich appointed Pamela A. Barker of Brecksville (Cuyahoga Co.) to serve as Judge of the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas.
