**OHIO FIRST LADY KAREN W. KASICH SERVES AS OHIO SAFE  
ROUTES TO SCHOOL AMBASSADOR**

COLUMBUS –First Lady Karen W. Kasich encourages Ohio’s 1.2 million students in grades K-8 to bike and walk to school as Ambassador for the Ohio Safe Routes to School “Every Move You Make, Keep It Safe” educational campaign spearheaded by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT).

The campaign not only encourages Ohio’s young students to walk and bike to school, it also educates students on the importance of traffic safety.
