**KASICH ISSUES RESOLUTION HONORING REVEREND FRED SHUTTLESWORTH**  
***Orders Flags at the Statehouse and in Hamilton County***  
***to be Flown at Half-Staff***

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich issued a resolution recognizing the life and work of Rev. Fred Shuttlesworth who passed away on October 5. Gov. Kasich ordered that all flags be flown at half-staff at the Ohio Statehouse and on all state-owned property in Hamilton County on Monday, October 24.

Rev. Shuttlesworth, a Baptist minister, was one of the founders of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference and worked closely with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to end segregation. He also founded and became a pastor of the Greater New Light Baptist Church in Cincinnati, and is a member of the Ohio Civil Rights Hall of Fame.
