**KASICH APPOINTS JOHN M. WILLIAMS TO HAMILTON COUNTY COURT OF  
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS - Today Gov. John R. Kasich appointed John M. Williams of Cincinnati (Hamilton Co.) to serve as judge of the Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division. He will assume office on November 14, 2011 and must run in November 2012 in order to serve out the remainder of the unexpired term ending February 13, 2015.

Williams earned his bachelor's degree from Xavier University and his juris doctor from the Thomas M. Cooley Law School. Since 2009, he has served as administrator of the Hamilton County Clerk of Courts. Williams also has served as Chief Assistant Prosecutor in the Hamilton County Prosecutor's office. He serves as a Board Member for the Talbert House.
