

Intelligrated to add 200 jobs

Ohio Governor John Kasich and Intelligrated on Monday announced that the automated materials handling company will add 200 jobs over the next three years.

The state of Ohio and Mason are offering a \$15 million incentives package to the company.

The announcement reflects continued growth of the company's operations since the state of Ohio provided a \$24 million incentive package in 2009 to triple the company's size and secure 537 existing jobs at three Ohio plants, and create at least 267 more over three years.

Intelligrated, one of Greater Cincinnati's largest privately held companies, doesn't disclose sales, but revenues were estimated at more than \$348 million last year.

The company employs about 2,000 nationally, including 800 in Ohio. Besides its Mason headquarters and engineering facility, which employs 200, Intelligrated employs about 400 at a nearly 300,000 square-foot plant in West Chester.
